It all depends on what the Department of Social Services / Human Resources Administration requires.

If taking one class this summer isn't included in my financial aid, I might take the summer off. I'll make the decision after speaking with HRA and seeing what the cost is to take one class this summer instead of two.

The online Baruch College website says I owe \$283 for Fall 2021. Can I pay that amount out of my Fall 2021 student loan refund? Or do I have to pay it before the semester starts?

If I'm allowed, I'll pay the balance due for fall 2021 out of my Fall 2021 student loan refund. If I'm required to pay the balance before then, I'll pay for the fall in the next few weeks.
